Beginning in May 2018, 225 students at Nakaseeta Foundation Primary Christian School began receiving two healthy meals a day, some for the first times in their lives. The teachers want you to know how much better the children are able to concentrate in class now that they're not struggling with constant hunger. One of the Primary seven students who was interviewed shared how many children were stealing food from neighbors in hopes of having anything to eat, and how happy she is that this isn't happening anymore at all.
